NUJ PRESS STATEMENT FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE

The National Union of Journalists Peninsular Malaysia (NUJM highlights the conclusion of the long deadlocked Collective Agreement between the Union and the Sun Media Corporation Sdn. Bhd..

We attribute the signing of the NUJ-Sun Media Corporation 2025-2027 CA on December 22, 2025 after a seven-year deadlock to the recommendation of former Human Resource minister YB Steven Sim Chee Keong who had encouraged the Sun Management to resume negotiation and promptly conclude the CA.

The NUJM had highlight the CA issue the former minister during the Engagement Session with Gig Workers (Sesi Libat Urus Rang Undang-Undang (RUU) Pekerja Gig 2025) on October 16th so that he could take some form of action through mediation with the Sun management and get both parties to resume negotiation for the sake of industrial harmony.

We express our deepest gratitude foremost to YB Steven Sim for his kind support and to the Sun management in response to his call and eventually concluding the CA with the Union.
